



## SITE RULES

We aim to make your visit to Lindsey Airsoft as enjoyable as possible but please ensure you follow the Safety rules & regulations detailed below:

1. When entering or leaving the site, please adhere to the site speed limit of 10mph. Treat local country lanes with caution, horses, livestock or machinery may be about.
2. Cars are parked at owners risk.
3. All players must sign an insurance waiver before they start the day.
4. Normal real gun safety code is expected – guns must always be treated as loaded and never be pointed at anybody unless in the Game Area and during a game.
5. No loaded Magazine to be fitted unless in the game area.
6. No Guns to be fitted with Magazines or discharged in designated Safe Areas
7. Magazines to be removed during cease fire periods, and removed and clear fired before leaving Game area.
8. Gun Muzzle velocities must be within UK standards. Lindsey Airsoft reserves the right to check gun muzzles at any time.
9. Suitable eye and body protection to be worn. Full-face masks are recommended and must be used by Novice players. No player will be allowed to participate in a game if the Marshals rule them to be inadequately protected. Lindsey Airsoft advises the use of head protection, but this is at your own discretion.
10. The wearing of knives is prohibited absolutely.
11. Minimum age to play is 12. Under 16s must wear a Full face mask when in combat zone.
12. One continuous blast on the Marshals whistle or air horn indicates a cease-fire! Stop shooting immediately, safety catches on.
13. No Targeting Wildlife.
14. Do not climb up or on trees.
15. The site is not open to the general public not having business with the site owners, but if a member of the public is encountered, all gaming activities to be ceased until they have moved out of the area and a marshal advised of their presence and location.
16. Some game areas are slippery and uneven, players should take adequate care when entering, or playing in these areas.
17. Be aware that there are fallen trees and logs on the ground; care should be taken around them.
18. Be aware of branches that are at head height, this is another reason that eye protection should be worn.



19. Be aware of steep gradients.
20. Structures permanent or temporary, which may be on the site to enhance the playing experience, should not be interfered with so as to render them unsafe - please report any potential hazards.
21. If a smoke grenade or flash bang is activated then do not attempt to pick it up or retrieve it as it will be very hot and may burn.
22. Admittance to the site of any person under the influence of alcohol or drugs shall be refused. No alcohol or drugs are permitted on the site.
23. When hit, players are advised to shout "Dead Man Walking", then to stand up and report to the designated dead area, or follow the Marshals directions. **Note;** these are not safe areas and facemasks should not be removed in these areas.
24. Avoid overkill.
25. Lindsey Airsoft does not allow violence, swearing at other players or the throwing of unapproved objects. We reserve the right to evict any participant(s) from the site who is in contravention of the site rules.
26. All Marshals have been chosen by Lindsey Airsoft as professional players, their word is final during a game. If you wish to you may appeal to Lindsey Airsoft.
27. Some areas may be marked "Out of Bounds" please respect this.
28. Please take note of any signs indicating you may be leaving the Game Areas or prohibiting fire in a particular direction.
29. Use of flash bangs and Smoke Grenades is subject to prior approval by Lindsey Airsoft.
30. Non-participants are excluded from the fire zone, and should not enter unless permission has been obtained from the Chief Marshals prior to commencement of the game.
31. Persons under 16 years may **only** play with signed permission from a parent or legal guardian.
32. Beware of vehicle movement throughout the time you are on the site.
33. Participants riding in site vehicles MUST listen to the driver's instructions at all times.
34. Standing up while a sit vehicle is moving is NOT permitted.
35. Boarding and alighting only allowed when the vehicle is static.
36. All of Lindsey Airsoft drivers are experienced drivers of the vehicles in operation.
37. Any person attending a Lindsey Airsoft event may be requested to leave the site at any time if the Marshals consider their conduct unsuitable, inappropriate or unsafe. No refund would be available in such circumstances.
